Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

The panel heard no new information that undermines the continuing necessity of an interim order.

The panel decided to confirm the interim suspension order in the case of Mr Jukes.

The panel took account of the information it received and noted that there had been no material change of circumstance since the order was imposed and last reviewed.

Accordingly, the panel was satisfied that the order remains necessary on the same grounds and for the same reasons as previously stated by the Investigating Committee panel at the last review on 2 August 2023.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim suspension order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the order at this meeting and Mr Jukes will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Mr Jukes is entitled to have the interim suspension order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Mr Jukes will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on his behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Mr Jukes must inform his case officer if he would like the interim suspension order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Mr Jukes does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Mr Jukes and his representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Mr Jukes in writing.
